2. Organize Questions by Topic or Difficulty

 Arrange your questions by topic or difficulty level. This organization will help you focus on specific areas and gradually increase the challenge as you gain confidence.

3. Reflection Questions

- How does organizing questions by topic or difficulty help you study more effectively?
- Are there specific topics that you found more difficult and want to focus on?



Part 4: Taking the Practice Test and Analyzing Results

1. Complete Your Practice Test

 Go through your practice test or quiz as if it were a real exam. Try to answer each question without looking at your notes.

2. Check Your Answers and Identify Areas of Struggle

 Review your answers and mark the questions you answered incorrectly. Pay special attention to areas where you struggled or were unsure.

3. Create a Study Plan Based on Results

 Based on the questions you missed, create a study plan that includes extra practice on specific topics. If possible, generate additional questions on these areas using the AI tool.

4. Reflection

- What topics do you need more practice with, and how will you address them?
